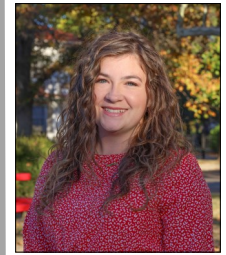


# I Am a Living Example



A JFA UPDATE FROM ALORA TUNSTILL

Dear Friend,

Twenty-two years ago, my life was almost ended through the process of an abortion. I am alive today by God's grace. Let me explain.

When my mom was nineteen she found herself unexpectedly pregnant. During the majority of her pregnancy she was using drugs. Since she was unmarried and felt unprepared for a child, she felt that abortion was her only option.

Because of how far along she was in her pregnancy, the abortion was a two-day procedure. While at the clinic for the first part of the procedure, she saw me on that ultrasound and heard my heartbeat. In that moment God intervened in a powerful way, and my mom left the clinic, saving my life. I was born four months later with no side effects from the drugs or the abortion procedure.

When my mom shared this with me, it helped me understand my identity in the Lord. I have always grown up in a Christian home. At a young age I told my dad I wanted to be in God's family. I understood that I was a sinner and needed Jesus to get into heaven. I prayed with my dad and asked Jesus to be the Lord of my life! Later on I began questioning my salvation and why God would love me. I struggled to know who I really was. Learning about my story and how my life was spared has given me a deep desire to use the gift of my life to speak for those who don't have a voice of their own.

By God's providence, my family moved to Arkansas, and there I was introduced to Justice For All (JFA) through local staff member Andrea Thenhaus. In the three years since, I have gotten to know Andrea and learn about her work. With persistence, she reached out and encouraged me to

Justice For All is a non-profit ministry that trains pro-life advocates to change hearts and minds about abortion. JFA invites Christians to participate in “Seat Work,” an interactive workshop which includes lectures, role-play, and mentoring in small groups. During the workshop, JFA trainers teach practical tools for balancing truth and compassion at each moment of the conversation.

JFA then facilitates “Feet Work,” a local outreach event where participants engage in conversations with students and faculty on a college campus with JFA trainers nearby to help. These conversations help people change their minds on abortion, but they also lead to opportunities to talk about God and share the gospel. This is why JFA fills a gap in discipleship as a partner to many churches and Christian schools. JFA takes people step by step from knowing very little to actually sharing the truth about unborn children and the gospel with people who desperately need the truth.

I want my story to bless others and impact the world. I hope you are inspired and feel compelled to join me as I seek to change lives with JFA.

I am currently serving as an intern with JFA, and I have accepted a position to serve as a JFA trainer based in Northwest Arkansas. I am responsible for raising support for this position, and my support goal is \$4,000 per month. Pledges of regular support (monthly, annual, etc.) and special gifts both help me to reach this goal.
