Fall 2006 Exhibits reached out to 105,000 ! (2004 and 2005 fall Exhibits together totaled 82,000)

Each fall, the Justice For All

(JFA) Exhibit travels to one or two universities in the Kansas, Oklahoma, Nebraska, Missouri or north Texas region. We actively seek to build educational partnerships with private schools in these Central Plains states.

The fall 2006 Exhibit at Wichita State (WSU) was highlighted and under-girded by pre-Exhibit training at Kapaun Mt. Carmel High School (400+ students), Trinity Academy (30 students & faculty), Central Christian Church (35 students), and WSU students and adults from the community (75).


For the past 9 semesters the JFA Exhibit has traveled to Colorado (CO), rotating between 4 CO universities once every two years. Over 1200 Focus on the

We keep divine appointments, but we don't usually get to

schedule them! It was evident from the start that the University of Texas—El Paso (UTEP) Exhibit was on God's calendar. Now we know why. *Former Embryos For Life (FEL) who sponsored the Exhibit, love God, actively share their faith in Christ, and are committed to helping babies and families at risk to abortion.*

El Paso and its sister city, Juarez, Mexico, separated only by the Rio Grande, have a combined population of 2.3 million! According to UTEP students, the bridge between El Paso and Juarez is not only a thriving

commercial thoroughfare, it has also become a *puerta giratoria* (revolving door) for Mexican women seeking abortions in El Paso.

Providentially, Arizona State University student, Rosa Camou, felt burdened last January to translate the JFA Exhibit brochure into Spanish! The graphic re-design and printing of 5,000 brochures will cost about \$6,500.

With help, FEL students hope to begin placing Spanish JFA Exhibit brochures into the hands of at-risk Spanish-speaking families by the fall of 2007. We'll report more on this opportunity early in 2007.

This [Exhibit experience] inspired me to do more in my community by teaching others the material I have learned! I plan on extending the Exhibit to local churches in my community by giving talks on abortion and teaching the youth to step up and feel comfortable to speak about abortion openly.
