She learned these life-saving skills at JFA's **Abortion: From Debate to Dialogue** training at Cal Poly-San Luis Obispo (2008), but only after convincing (begging?) her dad to allow her to participate!

Thirty conversations later, near the end of the 2nd day Exhibit day, Amanda approached a student named Laura who had stopped to view the JFA Exhibit. Laura, much later said, *"Before I saw the exhibit I was indifferent. Ironically, I was technically pregnant at the time I met Amanda, I just didn't know it!"*

After talking with Amanda for about 10 minutes, Laura said that she needed to go. Amanda wisely suggested that they trade email addresses to stay in touch.

Two months later Laura emailed Amanda to say that she was pregnant, and **thanks to** JFA, Amanda and Dominic (the baby's father), she was **not** going to get an abortion.

Amanda ask her parents if they could invite Laura and Dominic over for dinner. During a second visit in Amanda's home, Dominic and Laura told Amanda's parents that they wanted the kind of relationships they saw in Amanda's family. Amanda's dad told them that the most important thing in their family is their relationship with Jesus, and that they could have it as well. **They prayed to put their trust in Christ that day** and are planning on getting married soon!

Their son Donato (left), was born 7 days before Christmas 2008. A Christmas **birth**-day gift indeed!

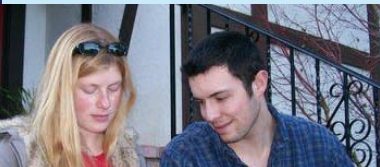
Justice For All's mission is to train thousands (**like Amanda**) to make abortion unthinkable for millions, one person (**like Laura**) at a time.
