### Housing Preferences

**Non-Smoking Homes, please.**

- A. **We try to house a minimum of 2 persons in one location, but only one per bed.** Exceptions are made for this in the case of married couples and female staff/volunteers. If at all possible, we prefer not to use sofa sleepers or air mattresses, please.
- B. It is our policy to not place our male staff in the homes of single/widowed women nor our female staff in the homes of single/widowed men.
- C. We ask that each host home please provide a light breakfast each day. (Guests will leave each morning in time to arrive on campus by 7 a.m.) You are not responsible to provide lunches or dinners, as they are provided for our team as a group. If you would like to sign up to host group lunch or dinner, please call or e-mail Rebecca. Thank you!
- D. We have our own transportation. It is helpful to have host homes within a 30 minute drive to campus (closer is better but we know it's not always possible).
