Host homes needed in Oklahoma City

10/25/2010—10/29/2010

- 1 married couples **Need Filled**

Host homes needed in Norman

- 3 married couples **Need Filled**
- 7 females **Need Filled**
- 8 males **Need Filled**

Housing Preferences

Non-Smoking Homes, please.

A. **Try to house a minimum of 2 persons in one location, but only one per bed.** Exceptions are definitely made for this in the case of married couples and female staff/volunteers. We prefer not to use sofa sleepers or air mattresses, please. (but again, we are open to whatever you can provide!)

B. It is our policy to house men from our team separate from the females. We do not place our male staff in the homes of single/widowed women nor our female staff in the homes of single/widowed men.

C. If host home could provide a light breakfast, that would be great! (Guests will leave each morning in time to arrive on campus by 7 a.m.) Dinners and lunches are provided for our team as a group. If you'd like to sign up to host one click [here](#).

D. We have our own transportation and it is helpful to have host homes within a 30 minute drive to campus (closer is better but we know it's not always possible).
