- Sandwiches – chicken salad, tuna salad, ham, turkey, roast beef (please leave meat sandwiches dry-we have mayo, mustard packets); Most of us like to eat healthy, so wheat bread is a preference.
- Cold or hot fried/baked chicken
- Sides - fruit, yogurt, chips, vegetables, cookies;
- Drinks - We have water at the site. You don't need to include a drink unless you really want to.

*FYI-We only take about 15-20 minutes away from the exhibit to eat and then return right to work so we don't leave the exhibit site all day once we arrive on campus (7 am-5:30 pm). Please provide prepared lunches. We can keep the lunches cool in our coolers but don't have a good area to prepare them ourselves.
