Here is a summary about our recent trainings. In 2010, the JFA team gave:

- **34 ADD seminars** (includes a few shorter interactive seminars) in which **1357 people attended.**
- Members of the JFA team also gave 38 presentations to approximately **3180** people.

The JFA team also did outreach events on 13 campuses in 9 states (GA, TN, CO, CA, LA, NE, OK, TX, and AZ)

At those campuses, **563 trained volunteers** helped create dialogue during our outreaches!

In addition, in 2010,

• 23 people participated as mentors in the JFA training program.

• 13 people actively sought training certification.
