However, since we will probably never see major newspaper headlines about the children killed by abortion, how will people hear the news? One of the unique things about the tragedy of abortion is that many of these deaths can be prevented by conversations that make the injustice unthinkable. It is always unbelievable to me how God uses our small team to reach so many people each semester. Each of those people could have an opportunity to save a child's life in the future, and prevent them from being added to the next monthly abortion statistic. Over the four years I've been doing this work, I've seen first-hand how a single conversation can really make a difference in someone's life and the lives of their future children.

On the reverse I have included a list of the events that were accomplished by our team this semester, some of which I participated in and some of which were led by others. Several of these were attended by a volunteer named Mark from right here in Texas. He is now retired, so he is using more and more of his time for ministry work. On our drive to our event at The University of New Mexico, he told me that of all the ministry work he is doing, he believes his work with Justice For All may be the most important. He explained it this way:

It recently dawned on me that defending God's most precious creation has to be near the top (if not the top) of things to prioritize in life. Another idea that recently struck me came from the updated *Evidence that Demands a Verdict* by Josh and Sean McDowell ... doing this on the university campus is the most influential place to do it in the Western World.


