That presentation included Austin's 11-year-old adopted son, Asher, and his birth mom. Asher's birth mom stressed that if she had not held pro-life convictions, abortion would have been the obvious answer for her. It was truly remarkable seeing Asher participate in our seminar and outreach: a boy who would not be here today if his mom was pro-choice, attempting to make abortion unthinkable for pro-choice college students.

Seeing Asher at work really brought our work full circle for me: we are helping to save children from abortion who will then go on to help save others.
