

Most followers of Justice For All know that our mission is to train thousands to make abortion unthinkable for millions, one person at a time. But how are we accomplishing that mission? What are our tools and strategies?

Our primary tool for accomplishing the mission is our pro-life training program which we call *Abortion: From Debate to Dialogue*. You can learn more at [www.jfaweb.org](http://www.jfaweb.org). How is our training program made available? The answer is regional mission teams. Justice For All’s long-term strategy is to raise up and plant fully-functioning mission teams in regions throughout the country. We are currently invested heavily in regions like Kansas, Oklahoma, North Texas, Atlanta, Phoenix, Colorado, and Central California. In each of these regions we have workgroups or teams who conduct the JFA training program which is accomplishing our mission.

Here in Oklahoma and North Texas, we have a dedicated workgroup which is well on its way to becoming a self-sustaining team. In the remainder of this letter, I will highlight the youth and vigor of our work in this region, the backbone of our volunteer core—The Three Amigos!
