## What to Expect

Our Spring Break mission trip is a rigorous, three-day leadership and discipleship training program held at <u>Camp Copass</u> in Denton, TX. The trip gives participants liberal access to JFA mentors, with continual opportunities to receive advanced training. This format produces a depth of knowledge, understanding, and wisdom in the participants beyond what is achievable in a schoolroom or Sunday school class.

# Registration

A gift of \$200 per person, not to exceed \$400 per family, is expected. Everyone age 12 and up is welcome. Parents are strongly encouraged to participate. Participants under age 18 must be accompanied by a parent, guardian, or designated adult supervisor. Each participant must submit a completed three-page <u>Medical</u> <u>Release & Permission Form</u>. Registration is complete upon receipt of the Medical Release & Permission Form and gift. We will confirm your registration by email. The deadline is February 28.

#### Meals

Almost all meals will be provided, beginning with Sunday lunch at check in. See details on the <u>Itinerary</u>. You will only need to plan for lunch on Monday and Tuesday while we are away from the camp ground, so bring some cash.

#### Travel

Camp Copass is located just six miles east of downtown Denton, TX on a peninsula of Lewisville Lake. The address is <u>8200 East McKinney Street</u>, <u>Denton</u>, <u>TX 76208</u>. Simply follow McKinney Street out of Denton until it dead ends at Camp Copass. If you are coming from the north, we recommend taking Loop 288 around Denton from I-35 to McKinney Street.

We encourage families, church groups, and co-ops to carpool as much as possible. We will be using personal vehicles to move from the camp to the outreach sites on Monday and Tuesday.

### Accommodations

We will be staying in the <u>Tally Retreat Center</u>, which features hotel-like rooms furnished with two queen size beds each. Some rooms have an additional twin fold-out bed. Linens are included.
