Providing a WAY for the WILLING

"The outreach is going well so far here at KU, but I mainly have encountered pro-life students, and we don't need to reach them. I just thank them for coming by, and I move on."

When a JFA volunteer at our University of Kansas (KU) outreach said this to me, I exclaimed, "What if I told you that it is *just as* significant to impact a pro-life person as it is a pro-choice person, and maybe *more*?

Three other volunteers at the same outreach were having a tough time knowing how to motivate the pro-life students they met. I sat



down with each of them and explained how pro-life students they meet might very well be arrogant, annoying, ignorant, or inactive, even if their pro-life convictions are genuine.

I also showed each of them the *Developing Heroes Instead of Spectators* letter that I originally wrote in December of 2008. I've used this letter to help hundreds of pro-lifers know how



to motivate their pro-life friends to wise action on behalf of the unborn. I've recently created an updated version and have enclosed it for you to read and share with someone you know.

Are you ready to help? Millions of pro-lifers are not prepared. Consequently they do nothing to stop the killing. They don't defend the humanity of the unborn. They don't challenge others. They find themselves lacking good tools and encouragement. Will you take a stand and help your pro-life friends step up, too?

Just last month I talked to a young lady in Oklahoma who had very little involvement in stopping abortion or equipping pro-lifers, even though she showed potential to be active: she was firmly pro-life, personally convicted about the injustice, and even said she would defend the unborn if the topic was brought up. I prepared her to take a stand with several of the resources listed in the *Developing Heroes* piece. Just a few days later she graciously challenged her small group Bible study. Praise God!
