What do you do when you have spent the last 28 years of your life swinging a hammer, doing what you are good at, **when God suddenly calls you to a totally different job?**

Less than 2 years ago Brit (my wife) asked me out of the blue, “Have you ever felt called to be a missionary?” My response? “No! And even if I did, I would only go somewhere cool, like Africa.”

Months later I was introduced to an organization called Justice For All (JFA).

Twelve months and 5 JFA mission trips later (from Georgia to California) God’s new calling on my life is hard to deny.

Brit and I have enthusiastically embraced JFA’s vision to engage the youth of

our culture, much like Paul did with the Greeks at Mars Hill, *without apology and without hostility.*

Even now I can’t explain what the Lord is doing in my life. At heart I’m just a simple carpenter. I have no prior “ministry” experience, yet I believe He is calling me to be a full time pro-life missionary with Justice For All.

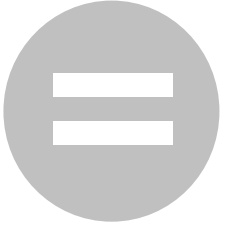
*The mission of JFA is to train thousands to make abortion unthinkable for millions, one person at a time.*

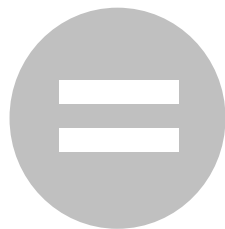
#### **2. Join my prayer support team.**
