Dear Friends,

He has stared death in the face several times. He lives 24/7 with physical impairment. Yet these trials have not kept him from regularly volunteering his time and energy to help Justice For All (JFA) for the past 6 years.

Frankly, he's one of my heroes. His high standard of commitment and work on behalf of JFA is a challenge to each of our staff and regular volunteers.

His name is Jeremy Wheeler. I have been privileged to know Jeremy and call him my friend for over 6 years. More importantly, Jeremy has been a

friend to unborn children and their families in working to help JFA train thousands to make abortion unthinkable for millions, one person at a time.

When we recently decided to hire building and operations management, rather than hire a maintenance company and people we don't know and who don't

know JFA, we asked Jeremy to consider joining the JFA team as a paid building maintenance supervisor. This will require his leaving his part-time job at a fast-food restaurant.

And since most of the JFA staff raise their own salary through a network of people and institutions who believe in JFA's mission, **Jeremy will need financial partners to support his part-time work with JFA (15-20 hours/week).** His goal will be to raise \$750 / mo for this work.

I asked Jeremy to share his experience with JFA as part of my introduction to invite you to become a member of Jeremy's financial support team. Here's what he said:

"I have known about Justice For All for six years. I've been on eight training/ outreach events with JFA to campuses that include Wichita State, Colorado State, UCLA, and the University of California--San Diego. ----> ...In each venue I saw firsthand people change their minds about abortion; others became pro-life due to their increased understanding I have had specific conversations with people who have had abortions and regretted them. These conversations were a springboard to spiritual conversation with each person.

The JFA Exhibit outreach creates effective debate on campus that trained volunteers turn into constructive dialogue. JFA reaches the people who statistically have the most abortions each year – 18-24

year olds. JFA has a clear vision and uses each resource to accomplish their mission.

My desire is to help JFA in whatever capacity is most strategic. I've volunteered in many ways over the years and would love to be a consistent part of this ministry and use my skills and energy for whatever is required and/or needed.

It is my hope that my friends would prayerfully consider partnering with me as I look to help make Justice For All more effective in living out their mission."
