



A couple weeks ago, I was writing emails to fellow supporters checking to see if they had received my newsletters. I received one reply that caught my eye.

It was from a high school student who had been to the JFA seat-work training back in March. I knew she needed help immediately because she had a neighbor who was pregnant and had <u>an abortion</u> scheduled for later that week.

I called her as soon as possible and talked with her mother. Much to my sorrow the mother told me the neighbor had already had the abortion that very morning.

Even more sadly, she told me this was the young woman's second abortion in 3 months.

There is a lesson we should learn from this tragic story. **Time is not on our side. If you know anyone considering abortion, call me anytime, day or night.**

Support Raising Update:

- ▶ I currently have 25% of my support needs met. I can't wait to connect with you about my mission and our current needs.
- ▶ I now have 29 supporters on my financial support team and many more on my prayer support team. Praise God for His provision!
- ▶ Out of 29 people who have pledged their support, 22 of them have given at least their first gift.
- ▶ I have 3 support dinners planned as of right now and several families praying about what they can do to help.

I don't want to leave you with only tragic news.
