During these next few months I am going to focus my attention on the city of Wichita and on the schools within a few hours of us, right here in the Wheat State!

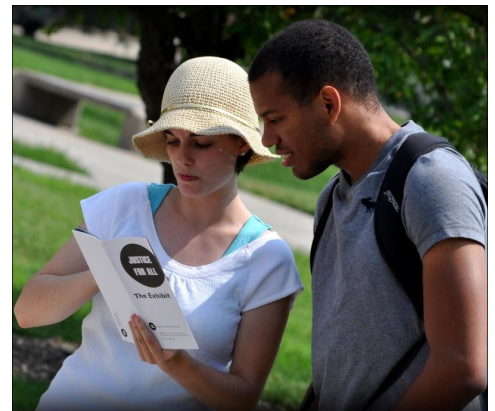
I'll still be traveling out of state a few times to assist with large events, recruiting, and networking.

Overall though, I'll spend the majority of time leading a small group of JFA staff (called a regional Work Group) to develop and serve volunteers by conducting seminars and outreach events locally. The schools I'll initially focus on for building up pro-life clubs and recruiting students are Wichita State University (WSU), Butler Community College (BCC), Emporia State University (ESU), Kansas University (KU), and Kansas State University (KSU). Most of the actual outreach events this fall will be right here at WSU.

A few other Work Groups will focus their attention on events near other key JFA hubs like Oklahoma City, Atlanta, Denver, and Phoenix.

Below is a rundown of a few of the networks we are blessed by and excited for:

Wichita, Kansas: Many of the JFA staff live here, and we are blessed to have committed volunteers and connections around town. Several students are forming a new pro-life club. This weekend we are having a seminar for their club kickoff.



Mcpherson, Kansas (45 minutes from Wichita): New Hope Evangelical Church in McPherson has interest in our program. Our seminar at their church is this week, and they have plans to work with us next semester too.

El Dorado, Kansas (30 minutes from Wichita): We have interest from several local groups including New Life Equipping Ministries and CRU (Campus Crusade for Christ at Butler Community College).

Emporia, Kansas (1 hour from Wichita): Students there have started a pro-life club that will regularly work with JFA. We also are connected to campus ministries and other pro-life organizations around town.

Derby, Kansas (15 minutes from Wichita): God has blessed us with a solid church partnership and with many positive leads from our intern, Cheryl Kaye Wisner. She has recruited several young adults to help.

Lawrence, Kansas (2.5 hours from Wichita): There is a new pro-life club forming at KU that is interested in our work. Several churches, including Morningstar Church, have also shown interest.



Staff member, **Jacob Burow (left, in blue)**, and JFA Intern, **Holly Meath (right)**, will shoulder a large part of the speaking and mentoring responsibilities for the many seminars we will have in Kansas this semester. Jacob has many years of experience with the JFA training program, and can be relied upon to lead in multiple ways.
