Dear Family and Friends,

Tears streamed down Paul's face as he told me about the cousin and sibling that he would never meet because they had been aborted. I listened as he shared the painful circumstances that had led to those tragic decisions, as well as the devastation that had followed—especially in his aunt's life.

Often, I hear stories like this from bitter and broken people. This time was different, though. Paul was broken, yes, but he had also

found healing. Tears still shining on his cheeks, he smiled as he talked about the family that had adopted him, the good news of God's forgiveness that he had come to know, and the forgiveness that he, in turn, had been able to show to his birth mom and his aunt.

Now it was my eyes that had tears in them.
