Last month, when I was in Oklahoma, I was encouraged by the story of a young woman who attended three JFA seminars in high school. After graduating, she headed off to college. On the first day of one of her classes, her professor divided the class into two groups, the students who were pro-choice and the students who were pro-life. (There were only two pro-life students.) The teacher then told them to debate the issue of abortion. Because of all the JFA training events she had attended, this young lady was able to hold her own against her entire class and present a persuasive case for the pro-life position.

At JFA we spend a lot of time and energy training pro-life people to defend their position in a loving way. There are many reasons we believe it's important to equip Christians in this way. The people we train may have opportunities to reach out to someone they know who is pregnant and considering abortion. They may have the opportunity to talk about abortion with a pro-choice friend.

They may even have the opportunity to defend their pro-life position to a class full of pro-choice students.

Every year, Christian students head off to college. In many cases they are not prepared for the attack on their faith and convictions that so often takes place on college campuses. It is so important that we equip our students to know not only what they believe but also how to give reasons for their beliefs. That way, rather than losing their faith and convictions during their college years, they can, like the young woman in the story above, lovingly and persuasively share the truth with others.
