Catherine Wurts, Ventura, CA, June 2007



Last year, though, a friend invited me to JFA's training called "Abortion: From Debate to Dialogue". The title caught my eye. I went, still skeptical.






Catherine, facing camera, listens & answers University of New Mexico students' questions here and below (right).
