Between writing projects and training events, I've neglected to share about an exciting project on which I've been working. It's JFA's Elementary Education Project. It is a curriculum for teaching elementary school children about life in the womb in a fun and memorable way. Our hope is that if children see what an unborn child looks like and learn a little about her development, it will make an impact on the children when they're older, particularly when they or someone they know is considering abortion. My colleague Catherine Wurts and I are hard at work on the prototyping phase of the project, and we're hoping to start teaching this material to students in elementary classrooms in Kansas and Oklahoma by the end of this year. Please pray for wisdom as we develop the curriculum and for opportunities for us to teach it.

On a more personal note, I am incredibly excited about a new Monday night discussion group I have started. It's modeled after a group in Georgia I attended for years (and still attend whenever I get the opportunity) called "English Tea Room" (though some of us still refer to it by its original name "Tea Party," which we changed when the conservative political movement stole it from us). The heart of the English Tea Room in Georgia is to encourage a


