For some, abortion is a full-time job. Who is working full-time to stop it?

I'm writing to tell you how I plan to do just that. I am going to work full-time as a training specialist for Justice for All (JFA). The purpose of this letter is to tell you about JFA and ask for your support.

Training thousands to make abortion unthinkable for millions, one person at a time is the mission of **JFA**, a pro-life organization based in Wichita, KS. With your faithful support I will help JFA accomplish this mission!

JFA recruits volunteers through a network of partnerships with Christian high schools, colleges, churches, and organizations. JFA's leadership formation develops future leaders into pro-active, pro-life advocates, all in the spirit of I Peter 3.15. Until the age of sixteen, I had the same attitude towards abortion as most Christians: **apathy**. I was blissfully and willingly ignorant to the reality of abortion. After hearing pro-life speaker Scott Klusendorf, God laid this problem on my heart. I realized that I hadn't considered the killing of unborn babies by abortion to be as morally significant as infanticide. I also learned that the frequency of abortions in the U.S is more than the number that died on 9/11, approximately 3500 every day.

How could I be so affected by 9/11, but be so complacent about the daily mass killing of the unborn?



My first experience with JFA was in 2007 at the University of Arizona. It was my freshman year at Biola. I felt like if I didn't win my arguments, more babies could die. It was hard for me to trust God with the results, and depressing when my best efforts to persuade people seemed so fruitless at times.

The JFA staff encouraged me to do my best to challenge people with the truth and leave the results to God. JFA did not want to skimp on truth, but they also seasoned their message with love. They seemed to be interested both in saving babies and helping their families, as opposed to simply focusing on unborn babies.

Last January I spent another week with JFA in Arizona, this time because I was considering working full-time with them.

I was optimistic already because of my positive experience during my freshman year but JFA still exceeded my expectations. I have been working in prolife ministry for eight years and I have never seen better training in pro-life apologetics. JFA's "Abortion: From Debate to Dialogue" training materials are excellent, and the JFA seminar is very interactive and practical.

Most importantly though, I was impressed with the very personal mentoring approach JFA takes. I'm excited to join a team of mentors who focus upon helping people learn content but who also work at campus outreaches to help volunteers learn to put content into context through dialogue about abortion with their peers.



During the JFA campus outreach I was continually amazed by how well trained the JFA staff are to defend the

pro-life view even when engaging people who are confused, argumentative or even angry. I have never seen a group of pro-life leaders balance truth and love so well. Suffice it to say, before the trip was over I knew I wanted to be a part of the JFA team and mission to train others to do the same.

I am so confident in the importance of JFA's mission and the effectiveness of their methods that I am going to move to Wichita, KS and join their staff fulltime for the foreseeable future. My first priority as a training specialist will be mastering their material and their mentoring approach. I not only want to grow as a mentor myself, but I also want to learn how to teach others to be effective ambassadors for Christ. Before I can move to Wichita, I need to raise my salary through a team of likeminded supporters. I hope to have my full support raised by this fall.
