### **General Information**

Justice For All ([www.JFAweb.org](http://www.JFAweb.org)) is offering a three-day Pro-Life Camp for homeschool families to be held at Camp Copass ([www.campcopass.com](http://www.campcopass.com)) in Denton, TX. Dates are Sunday, November 6<sup>th</sup> through Tuesday, November 8<sup>th</sup>.

The camp will prepare participants to be gracious pro-life ambassadors for Christ. Participants will gain an understanding of the problems surrounding abortion, as well as the opportunities for Christians to minister in this arena. They will learn to make the biological and philosophical cases for life, be prepared to handle the hard questions of rape and life/health of the mother, and they will personally experience the opportunity for evangelism in every conversation during an outreach event designed to engage campers with people in our culture who need to hear the truth about abortion.

### **Registration**

There is no fee to register for the camp, but a donation of \$25 per person or \$50 per family is suggested. Only 40 slots are available, so register today.

Everyone age 12 and up is welcome. Parents are strongly encouraged to participate. Campers under age 18 must be accompanied by a parent, guardian, or supervisor or be part of an adult-supervised group.

Check-in time on Sunday, November 6<sup>th</sup> is from 10:00 AM to Noon. Check-out time is Wednesday, November 9<sup>th</sup> before 10:00 AM.

### **Meals**

JFA will provide Sunday lunch and evening meals. Please bring cash or coolers to cover lunches on Monday and Tuesday. An ice machine is available. Breakfast will be served in the camp dining hall Monday through Wednesday. The price is TBD.

### **Travel**

Camp Copass is located just six miles east of downtown Denton, TX on a peninsula of Lewisville Lake. The address is 8200 East McKinney Street, Denton, TX 76208. Simply follow McKinney Street out of Denton until it dead ends at Camp Copass.

We encourage families, church groups, and coops to carpool as much as possible. We will have to use personal vehicles to move from the camp to the local university on Monday and Tuesday.

### **Accommodations**

We will be staying in the new Tally Retreat Center, which features hotel-like rooms furnished with two queen size beds each. Linens are included.
