Why attend?

Justice For All's "ADD" 4.5 hour seminar prepares participants to:

- Start respectful conversations of moral substance and value.
- Ask the right questions; keep conversations focused.
- Practice listening skills.
- Direct those in crisis and/or need to qualified counselors.
- Fish for people (Mark 1.17).
