The lady pictured lower left is prolife, but she was lacking in knowledge about fetal development and abortion procedures. I spent time helping her understand abortion better, and she was disturbed by the details of how abortions are performed. She left thanking us for being on campus.



As soon as I asked Shane (above) what he thought of the exhibit, he pulled out his phone and showed me a picture of an ultrasound. His wife is pregnant with their first son. He spent four years in the Marine Corps, and he is close to graduat-



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ing from college now. We discussed the abortion problem in America, and I trained him to talk more effectively about the issue. I also gave him a brochure, encouraging him to share the truth about abortion with his friends.

Former staff member Laura Beeson (drevious page) spent a long time talking to the students who were protesting our exhibit. Amazingly, there was no shouting or yelling the whole time! This is common when our trained people listen to the opposition. Another thing I love about JFA is that we don't have to yell to be heard.
