## No Facts, No Plan, No Confidence

Dear Friends and Family,

Jennifer had “no facts, no plan, and no confidence” to dialogue with others about abortion, let alone with students at the University of North Texas (UNT), one of Texas’s most liberal colleges.

I was her mentor during Justice For All’s (JFA) *Abortion: From Debate to Dialogue* seminar this past November. With such a dire outlook, could I prepare Jennifer for what she would encounter on UNT’s campus? *“Though I have always been very pro-life, I had never done any pro-life work. I had not done research on abortion or practiced defending my view. I had no facts, no plan, and no confidence. In short, I was not ready for any conversation with someone who was pro-choice...”*

*The training proved to be exactly what I needed, equipping me with the knowledge and skills I lacked...*

*My first conversation at the campus outreach consisted of a tour of the exhibit. That was a great conversation to start with.*

*Later, I talked to a girl who was standing across the sidewalk looking uneasy. She thought abortion was very bad, but also thought it should*



*be the woman’s choice. She was open, and we had a very good conversation. Afterwards, she walked up to the poll table, started to sign that abortion should be legal, but then signed that it shouldn’t! ...*

*Thanks to the training and outreach, I am pretty confident in starting a conversation about abortion, and I am equipped with the skills and tools I need...*
