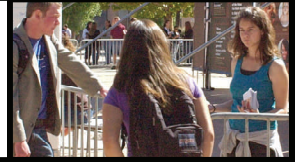

Dear Supporters,

Exciting news! Several months ago I was asked to take a regular staff position with the Justice For All (JFA) team. I'm happy to announce that I have accepted the position and will begin in December after my two-year internship is completed.

My internship with JFA has deepened my understanding of our mission,

**To TRAIN thousands, to MAKE ABORTION UNTHINKABLE for millions, ONE person at a time.**

While the JFA team of 20 staff may not be able to talk to millions on our own, our mission is not to do all the talking ourselves. It is to train others.
