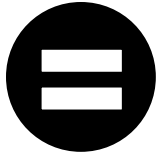

Dear Friends of Truth and Life,

Training thousands to make abortion unthinkable for millions, one person at a time is the mission of Justice For All (**JFA**), a pro-life organization based in Wichita, KS. **With your faithful support I will help JFA accomplish this mission!**

As you may know, I recently returned to Nebraska from the Justice for All 2009 May Mission in California. I had a wonderful time and learned several key lessons.

This mission included training for college students and community members in California, advanced training for volunteers on the trip, and presentations of the JFA Exhibit on the campuses of Pasadena City College (PCC) and the University of California-San Diego (UCSD).

During training I was taught a valuable lesson. I learned the necessity of being able to **"train others so that they can also train others how to defend life."** In order for abortion to come to an end more people need to know how to have a bold and wise plan to stop it.

I saw the effectiveness of this "training others to train others" first hand during the community/student

training. I helped JFA conduct 2 training sessions. One with over 60 participants and another for about 25 participants. It was exciting to see how engaged and motivated the participants were to learn to defend the unborn.

One of my favorite activities involved a JFA staff member defending the pro-choice position. Seven to ten participants then used the new skills they learned from the training to break down the pro-choice argument. It was amazing to watch faces light up as participants gained confidence in defending the life of the unborn, even when faced with difficult and uncomfortable questions.

The training became more exciting as it traveled onto college campuses. The participants from the training joined the JFA Exhibit and put their new skills to use.



what they had learned. One of the girls even responded by saying "Thanks for taking the time to enlighten us."

There are many more stories to share from my experiences in California. Maybe I will be able to share more of my experiences with you in person.

Here are a couple of my own personal stories from the college campuses:

During my first day with the JFA Exhibit at PCC, I approached a young woman named Marfelia. She shared that she had a good friend who had an abortion about 2 months prior. We discussed the exhibit and I offered her a small brochure that is a replication of the JFA Exhibit. **We spent about 10 minutes going through it so she could effectively explain it to others.** She was excited to take the brochure so she could share it with another friend whom she felt had a high possibility of having an abortion in the future. She then looked at me and said "I wish I would have had this 2 months ago."

The 3rd day at PCC I watched two girls walk past the exhibit in disgust. They were both cringing and one of the girls looked at her friend and said "Oh that's so gross! What is that!?" I took the opportunity to stop them and offer an explanation of what the pictures showed. They were astonished that an abortion looked so horrible, but then they were even more horrified to discover what an abortion really entailed. Using the exhibit and the series of pictures that show the development of life, we discussed when life begins, etc. They had never seen pictures like that before.

As the conversation ended the girls were excited to take the JFA brochure to share
