She experienced her first JFA outreach and met our staff in 2006 at Arizona State University.

I first met Lori at a training in Tucson early in 2011. Toward the end of that training day, we gave Lori the microphone so she could share her story and answer questions. The audience loved her. After having been engaged in practice dialogue all day, the students finally tasted reality when Lori spoke to them. She gave some timely advice on how to watch for someone who needs a listening ear, compassion, and forgiveness. She is a wonderful soul with a powerful testimony.
